Campbell, California — After an extensive recruitment and selection process, the City Council has agreed to the selection of Brian Loventhal as the new City Manager. Mr. Loventhal will begin as City Manager on December 5, 2016.

Mayor Jason Baker noted, "The City Council is very pleased to have selected a skilled and experienced City Manager. We are delighted that Brian has accepted the City Manager position. He brings eighteen years of successful city management experience in our region. The Council is confident he has the skills and abilities to lead Campbell. Brian is a proven leader in the city management profession who has the ability to maintain the level of excellence in Campbell, while improving upon the City's successes. The City Council looks forward to Brian joining the City in December."

Brian Loventhal currently serves as the City Manager for the City of Monte Sereno where he reports to a five-member City Council and directs the daily operations of the city staff.

Mr. Loventhal brings extensive experience in community development and planning, budgeting, intergovernmental relations, strategic planning, and policy analysis. Moreover, he is strongly committed to working cooperatively with elected officials, advisory bodies, staff and community members.

Mr. Loventhal is a member of the California Bar Association and holds a Juris Doctorate Degree from Santa Clara University and a Bachelor of Arts in Urban and Regional Planning from the California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo. He is a member of many professional organizations including the International City/County Management Association (ICMA); the City Managers Department, League of California Cities ("League"); the Two-County Next Generation Committee, and the Santa Clara County/City Managers' Association (SCCCMA). He is married to Nicole Loventhal and they have two children. He has lived in San Jose for fourteen years.

On his selection Brian Loventhal commented, "Campbell is a great city with a reputation as an outstanding organization. I am honored to be selected to lead the organization and I am excited

to begin working with the Council, staff, and community to build on the excellent foundation that has been laid over years."

The City of Campbell operates under the "Council-Manager" form of government. The City Manager is appointed by the City Council and is responsible for implementing policies adopted by the City Council and for administering the day-to-day operations of the City. The City Manager implements municipal laws, makes recommendations to the Council, prepares and manages the municipal budget, appoints all employees, oversees City Department Heads, and supervises the operations of all City departments.
