NOTICE OF DECISION

Tree Removal Permit

Notice is hereby given that the Community Development Director of the City of Campbell has **DENIED** the following application for a Tree Removal Permit:

Basis of Decision: Based upon a review of the application materials and an inspection of the property, the Community Development Director has denied removal of one cedar tree located in the front yard of the address above. The applicant's reason for removal is overcrowding of other protected trees; however per Campbell Municipal Code Section 21.32.080 the Community Development Director may only approve a Tree Removal Permit after making at least one of five findings: (1) Diseased or Danger of Falling, (2) Structure Damage, (3) Utility Interference, (4) Overplanting, or (5) Economic Enjoyment and Hardship. The Community Development Director has determined the required findings for removal have not been met because while the subject cedar tree is located in close proximity to existing redwood trees, there is no indication of overcrowding that would impact the redwood trees' long-term viability therefore Finding (4) Overplanting cannot be substantiated.

Appeal Process: Decisions by the Community Development Director are final in 10 calendar days following the date of approval, unless an appeal is received in writing at the City of Campbell Community Development Department, 70 N. First Street, Campbell, prior to the end of the appeal period – **October 23, 2017**. A written appeal must be accompanied by the required \$750 appeal filing fee.
