Dear Business Owner and/or Resident,

The City of San José has contracted with **O’Grady Paving** to provide resurfacing treatment on your neighborhood streets to extend the service life and improve ride quality.

PLEASE BE AWARE: At least 48 hours prior to paving operation, **TOW AWAY - NO PARKING** signs will be posted. In order for the contractor to adequately perform the work, the streets will need to be clear of vehicles, trailers, and any other obstructions. Vehicles or trailers left in the posted area will be cited and towed.

We understand that this project may create some inconveniences. We will do our best to minimize the amount of disruption.

Thank you for your understanding, cooperation, and patience as we work to maintain San José’s roads.



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Spray paint markings for utility identification purposes ▪ Installation or upgrades of ADA curb ramps 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Low to no impact.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Public trees will be pruned to provide sufficient clearance for paving equipment and vehicles ▪ Unsafe public trees might be completely removed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ On-street parking might be limited for a short period. ▪ Call (408) 794-1901 if you wish to prune public trees adjacent to your property yourself.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ ON PAVING DAYS: Lane closure and traffic detour, except for emergency vehicles Cracks and failed pavement areas will be repaired. Old pavement surface will be removed and replaced with new asphalt concrete. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ LANE CLOSURES AND TRAFFIC DETOURS ▪ NO PARKING – TOW-WAY: Violated vehicles will be cited and towed away

TIPS FOR PAVING DAYS

THINGS TO REMEMBER



Anticipate the Final Notice to arrive at your door about 48-72 hours prior to paving day.



Pay attention to the “TOW AWAY - NO STOPPING”, detours, and temporary traffic control signs.



When traveling in the construction zone, slow down and stay alert. Be ready for changes in traffic patterns.



Newly paved surface will need to be protected in 2-5 hours to cure before returning to traffic.



Construction workers are out there to help. They will be able to let you know when it is safe to drive.



Trash collection might occur either earlier in the day before paving operation if they happen to be on the same day.



Street repaving is a good thing, but it can be inconvenience to uninformed residents.



For special accommodation, contact the contractor using the number provided on reverse side.

THINGS TO DO

Carefully read the information on this Final Notice to schedule your essential travel and activities accordingly.

Move your vehicles and/or trailers away from the restricted areas in advance.

Plan extra time for travel, leave before 8am, and return after 4:30pm.

DO NOT DRIVE on fresh pavement as it might damage the street and driveway in front of your house.

If you encounter any unsafe situation or need special accommodation, inform any field worker immediately.

Leave your trash bins out the night before paving day for potential early pick up. To report missed collections visit sanjoseca.gov/311, dial 3-1-1 or call (408) 535-3500.
